### **COVID-19 Practice Protocols**



# What practice safety protocols has your practice implemented and how long will you continue to keep them in place?


#### Restricted seating in waiting room (6-ft. distancing)

#### Patients waiting in cars until called for appointment







#### All patients & visitors required to wear masks






#### Additional practice protocols currently in place among responding practices.






**Note:** There was little change in responses regarding compliance and informed consent from last year at this time.
